This course is designed for Early Career Teachers (ECTs) or those who are new to teaching PSHE education. The session will also look at how the expectations for personal and professional conduct relate to teaching PSHE education. This section will focus on ethics and behaviour including safeguarding, fundamental British Values and impartiality.

This course will support ECTs in meeting the Teachers' Standards as set out by the DfE.

- To develop an understanding of PSHE education including the statutory elements of Relationships and Health education
- To explore how to create a safe learning environment including how to handle sensitive and controversial issues
- To consider how to plan high quality PSHE education lessons including meeting the needs of different learners.
- To begin to develop an understanding of using assessment effectively in PSHE education
- To explore the expectations for personal and professional conduct in relation to PSHE education
