Course Overview

During this online session we will discuss ways that pupil voice and participation can be used as an effective tool for school improvement. We will look at the reasons for developing effective pupil voice in school and consider ways it can be implemented. We will look at how to collect data and using this to inform school improvement.

We will also consider the roles that children and young people can take on to support their personal development and contribution to school life.

A range of practical strategies for engaging children and young people in school improvement will be outlined. Throughout the session we will consider how we can be inclusive of all groups in the school community.

Course Content:

- consider how pupil voice and data collected from it can contribute to school improvement;
- develop strategies to engage children in consultation;
- discuss the roles that children might take on in school to support their personal development and school improvement;
- explore ways to include everyone in pupil voice activities;
- using pupil voice to improve lunchtimes, playtimes and extra-curricular activities;
- identify challenges around pupil voice.
