Overview of Training:

This online training will allow delegates to strengthen their subject knowledge and pedagogy of mathematics in Years 1 & 2.

The training will explore some of the potential gaps that children may have and begin to consider how they might be supported to work towards achieving age-related expectations.

This will be a hands-on session, so come armed with manipulatives and you may wish to have your scheme of learning to hand, as there will be an opportunity to reflect on your provision.

Course Content

- Overview of KS1 mathematics;
- Identify key learning in Years 1 & 2 and consider strategies to meet end-of-year Ready to Progress (RTP) statements;
- Explore structures and representations to support concepts taught;
- Strategies to develop automaticity in numbers bonds within 10 and 20;
- Applying knowledge to develop reasoning;
- Support in exploring barriers which might prevent pupils from achieving age-related expectations;
- Strengthen strategies to support pupils in applying their learning in more challenging problem-solving contexts;
- Using picture books to develop mathematical understanding;
