Overview of Training:

This online course will help you to plan and teach effective writing sessions that will support your children to achieve the 'Expected' standard at the end of KS2 – and help them to be ready for KS3.

- Unpick the Expected Standard and use all available materials to fully understand the expectations, to inform teaching and to make accurate judgements
- select strategies and resources to overcome barriers e.g. lack of 'staying power', engagement and motivation, gaps in learning
- teach the key skills in vocabulary, grammar and punctuation needed to meet the 'Expected' standard
- develop children's transcription skills – identify and overcome barriers to success in spelling and handwriting
- develop children's composition skills and develop their skills in proof reading, editing and improving
- plan and teach exciting and motivating 'extended units' designed to give opportunities to develop skills as well as providing a range of independent writing evidence covering fiction and non-fiction
- motivate even the most reluctant writers, through the use of invented/real audiences and purposes, quality texts, film and 'real-life' experiences
- develop an effective plan to collect writing evidence for internal/external moderation
