Overview of Training:

This online Zoom course will explore key mathematics and pedagogical ideas for Years 5 and 6, underpinned by the aims of the national curriculum and the five big ideas of teaching for mastery (coherence, representation and structure, mathematical thinking, fluency and variation).

This CPD opportunity would be suitable for Early Career Teachers and Teaching Assistants in Years 5 & 6 as well as staff who have recently changed year group or who are looking to develop their subject knowledge.

Course content:

- Overview of mathematics in Upper KS2;
- Identify key learning in Years 5 & 6 and consider strategies to meet end-of-year Ready to Progress (RTP) statements;
- Develop a conceptual understanding of fractions and decimals;
- Consider manipulatives that can be used to further strengthen understanding;
- Support in exploring barriers which might prevent pupils from achieving age-related expectations;
- Strengthen strategies to support pupils in applying their learning in more challenging problem-solving contexts.
